Ballerina

Hybrid Musk. Wonderfully fragrant flowers bloom in hydrangea-like clusters all season long. Dense, hardy and vigorous. An outstanding landscape plant. (1937) ✨

Zephirine Drouhin

Bourbon. Alkaline soil, pollution, shade – this hardy climber handles it all. Large, sweetly scented, deep-pink blooms on nearly thornless stems. Dense foliage. (1868) ✨
